CATHOLIC SCRIPTURE STUDY

The Second Vatican Council, destined to be seen as one of the most significant events in the life of the Catholic Church, called all Catholics to pay greater attention to the Word of God in Scripture. Heeding Saint Jerome's words of over fifteen hundred years ago --"Ignorance of the Scriptures is ignorance of Christ"--, the Fathers of the Second Vatican Council called for the Scriptures to be made more available to all Catholics by having the Scriptures read in the vernacular languages at Mass and by having three readings instead of two at each Sunday Mass and by having a three year cycle of readings rather than the one year cycle of the Tridentine Mass. This means that if we participate regularly in Mass each weekend over years and years, we will hear and become familiar with a very large portion of the Scriptures. In addition, we are encouraged to read and study the Scriptures regularly. The Catholic Scripture Study scheduled for the Fall in our parish is being offered to provide an opportunity for all of us to learn more about the Scriptures and about Jesus Christ. If you have not

already registered, please consider doing so. You will be glad you did.

LITURGY COMMITTEE NOTES

Did you know?

It is in response to the self-righteous, spiritually skilled, pride-filled Pharisees' table behavior that Jesus paints a picture (parable) of the great Heavenly banquet and who should be the guests at such an event: Invite 'the poor, the crippled, the lame and the blind.'" (Luke 14:13) This parable reminds us of the great messianic banquet that is being celebrated eternally in Heaven. The great feast of heaven is an image of the reign of God, where there will be no more suffering, no more tears, no more sadness, no more inequality, and no more injustice. The great feast of heaven is an image of what we are journeying to in our lives of faith, here on earth. In the Eucharist we have a taste of what awaits us eternally, at the heavenly banquet. There, when all wisdom is given to us and we have eternal life, we will enter forever around the table of the Lamb, in true and complete communion with him.

Today's scripture calls us to humility and to attentiveness to the humble. Humility is a virtue not greatly esteemed in our competitive society. Sirach offers some practical insights, and the Gospel teaches the meaning of humility in parable form – the heavenly banquet to which the marginalized are invited. The reading from Hebrews contrasts the two covenants, pointing out the blessedness and joy proper to the new dispensation. In verse 25, not included, the author exhorts his readers (us) to listen to God's voice.
